- Up to 6 hours independent study (ENGL 8900) approved by the Director of Graduate Studies
- Up to 9 hours in related courses outside the department

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Thesis Research – 6 hours

- Students may take more than 6 hours once coursework is completed.
- Extra thesis hours cannot count towards coursework requirements.
